**The policies stated below will be adjusted to meet any Covid-19 Regulations that may be in effect during our 2021 season. You will be notified of these changes once you have been accepted. Otherwise the policies go into effect September 1, 2020.**

RE: Lodging Policy  
To: Ice Artists and Out-of-Town Volunteers  
Purpose: The Lodging Policy is to establish the guidelines in which Ice Alaska will provide lodging for visiting ice artists and volunteers. The following guidelines shall be effective as of the above date.

#### **Ice sculptors**

- ❑ Sculptors accepted to compete in the World Ice Art Championships shall be provided lodging if they live more than 25 miles from the Tanana Valley Fair Grounds. Two sculptors per room. Teammates will be paired. Where necessary sculptors from different teams will be paired. **For other arrangements see below.**
- ❑ The lodging dates paid for by Ice Alaska begin two (2) nights before the start of your competition and continues through the night of the Competition(s) Award Ceremony. **Each sculptor is responsible for paying any additional room charges** (IE. room service, etc.).
- ❑ **Sculptors must contact the hotel directly to pay and arrange for additional nights for themselves and/or any guests (spouses, children, friends, significant others) they wish to bring.**
- ❑ Sculptors may purchase additional rooms or upgrades, if available, but they must make the arrangements directly with the hotel and pay the hotel directly. Accommodations is NOT provided by Ice Alaska for friends, family, or other guests.
- ❑ Our Host Hotel is a 100% drug free zone. The usage of marijuana, paraphernalia, vaping pens, and smoking are NOT allowed in the rooms, on the balconies, or even on the property. If you wish to use any of the above items, you must find your own hotel and pay for your own room.
- ❑ If you are asked to leave the hotel for any reason, use of drugs or misconduct, Ice Alaska will NOT be responsible for any penalties, cleaning fees, or any lodging.
- ❑ All Boot Camp participants, once accepted, will be treated as sculptors. See above. Others who wish to contribute to the Kid's Park must have a project in mind and have it approved by Steve Brice before their lodging will be provided by Ice Alaska. Talk to him before you come.

## Out-of-Town Volunteers

- ❑ Ice Alaska will provide lodging for those out-of-town individuals **accepted** as an Ice Alaska volunteer. To be accepted one of the 14 Section Chairs must have a volunteer position available. **The individual must agree to fill the open position and the individual must be willing to volunteer for at least 6 hours per day for 10 days.** One day out of the 10 may be a day off **as determined by the Section Chair**. Lodging at Ice Alaska's expense will not be provided unless the above-mentioned criteria is met. Ice Alaska may provide meals for out-of-town volunteers not meeting the lodging criteria when they are working.
- ❑ Volunteers, meeting the above lodging criteria shall have the lodging paid from the night before active volunteering to the night of the last active day.
- ❑ Rooms will be double occupancy unless other arrangements are made.
- ❑ Volunteers may purchase additional rooms or upgrades, if available, but they must make the arrangements directly with the hotel and pay the hotel directly. Accommodations is NOT provided by Ice Alaska for friends, family, or other guests.
- ❑ Our Host Hotel is a 100% drug free zone. The usage of marijuana, paraphernalia, vaping pens, and smoking are NOT allowed in the rooms, on the balconies, or even on the property. If you wish to use any of the above items, you must find your own hotel and pay for your own room.
- ❑ If you are asked to leave the hotel for any reason, use of drugs or misconduct, Ice Alaska will NOT be responsible for any penalties, cleaning fees, or any lodging.

Deviations to this policy may only be approved by the President of Ice Alaska or his/her delegate. Such approval shall only be in writing and on a case by case basis. This Lodging Policy is intended to be fair and equitable to everyone participating in the BP World Ice Art Championships.
